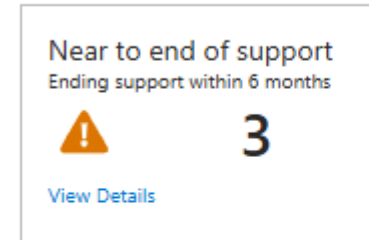

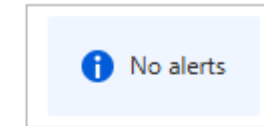

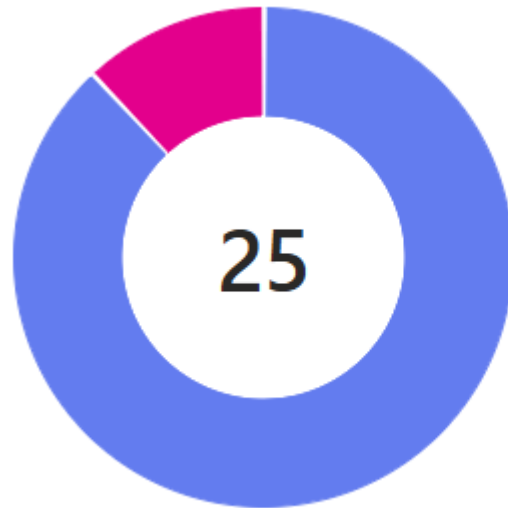

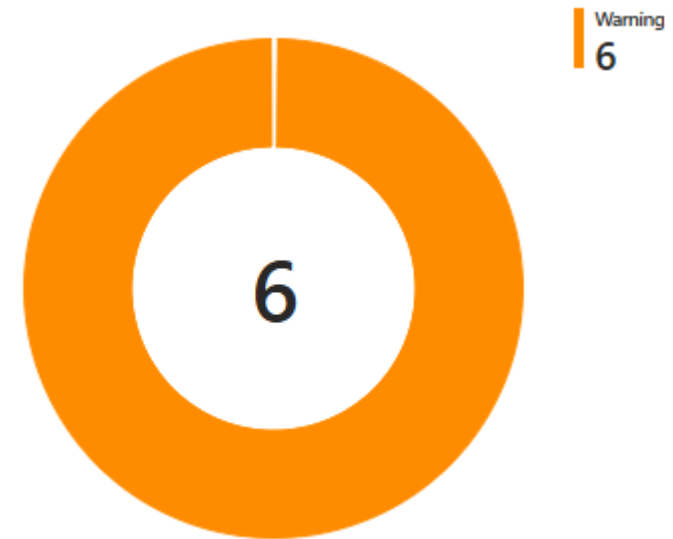

Microsoft Compatibility Appraiser

- Task Scheduler
 - Microsoft > Windows > Application Experience
 - Microsoft Compatibility Appraiser
- Registry
 - HKLM\Software\Microsoft\Windows NT\CurrentVersion\AppCompatFlags\TargetVersionUpgradeExperienceIndicators

Options for Incompatible Devices

- Resolve compatibility issues if possible
 - Enable or upgrade TPM
 - Disable legacy boot support and enable Secure Boot
 - Add additional RAM or a bigger hard drive
- Purchase new hardware
 - Now Micro is partnered with Dell, HP, Lenovo, and More

Options for Incompatible Devices Cont.

- Extended Security Updates (ESU) Program
 - Annual subscription fee for up to 3 additional years of updates
 - [Microsoft Documentation](#)
- Windows 10 Long-Term Servicing Channel (LTSC)
 - Updates available until late 2020s
 - Typically not installed on standard end-user devices
 - Lacking features compared to the GA versions of Windows
 - [Microsoft Documentation](#)

Options for Incompatible Devices Cont.

- Install Windows 11 in an unsupported configuration
 - Not recommended
 - Not guaranteed to receive updates in the future
 - Some features may not work
 - Possible system instability

Start Menu Customization

- Preference (Default, user can change)
 - Configure the Start menu, then copy the “Start.bin” file
 - AppData\Local\Packages\Microsoft.Windows.StartMenuExperienceHost_cw5n1h2txyewy\LocalState\start.bin
 - Copy the “Start.bin” file to the default user profile
- Policy (Forced, user cannot change)
 - Export-StartLayout -Path "C:\StartLayout.json"
 - ./Device/Vendor/MSFT/Policy/Config/Start/ConfigureStartPins

Taskbar Customization

- Preference (Default, user can change)
 - Configure a “LayoutModification.xml” file
 - Copy the “LayoutModification.xml” file to the default user profile
- Policy (Forced, user cannot change)
 - Configure a “LayoutModification.xml” file
 - ./Device/Vendor/MSFT/Policy/Config/Start/StartLayout/Configure start layout
 - Computer Configuration > Administrative Templates > Start Menu and Taskbar

- Improved Window snap and snap groups
- Improved Settings application

Windows 11 24H2

- Available as an optional update on September 24th and generally available on October 8th
- New Features
 - Improved Co-pilot integration
 - Native support for .zip, .7z, and .tar files
 - Sudo for Windows
